

REHEARSALS

Psalms 22:4, "Our fathers trusted in You, they trusted and You delivered them. They cried out to You and were delivered; they trusted in You and were not ashamed." (or disappointed.) NKJ Psalms 9:1, "I will praise You, O Lord, with my whole heart; I will show forth (recount and tell aloud) (rehearse) all Your marvelous works and wonderful deeds!"AMP David practiced over and over what God had done in the past and spoke out loud, and his own heart and all who heard these words were encouraged and their faith was strengthened! I could myself say...."I remember when...!!"

Psalms 77:10-15, "But I will remember the years of the right hand of the Most High. I will remember the works of the Lord; surely I will remember Your wonders of old. I will also meditate on all Your work, and talk of Your deeds. Your way, O God is in the sanctuary; Who is so great a God as our God? You are the God Who does wonders; You have declared Your strength among the peoples."

Read Psalms 103:2-5 and Psalms 78:4 and rehearse all the benefits of the Lord so as to not forget! In days ahead we must not only rehearse often how the Lord has come through for each of us and our families when facing difficulties but we must tell our children, grand-children and great-children about the faithfulness of God!! Our God will be so blessed to hear His children boasting in Him! He is worthy of all our praise!!
