But in verse 35 the Word says "And so said all the disciples." They ALL denied Him!

We read that when Jesus was in the Garden of Gethsemane He asked three of His disciples to watch and pray as He cried out in agony and three times He came to them and found them sleeping. When they came to arrest Jesus verse 56 says, "Then all the disciples forsook Him and fled."

John 21:1-17 is such a beautiful description of our Jesus and His unconditional love! He didn't condemn them or make them feel shamed and guilty. and new beginnings.





Thank you to all who generously donated!! We were able to bless 712 children through our Christmas Outreach Program!!


