FEED THE PEOPLE !!

This past month has been an extremely frightening time for many of the people whom we serve at Grace Place. Food insecurity is something most of them battle with daily, but with the threat of SNAP food benefits being reduced or taken away, it has caused much fear and anxiety. We are continuing to feed more people than ever, and we are seeing lots of new individuals and families.

We were interviewed this past month by one of our local news stations, the Times Picayune in NOLA, and even the NY Times!!! The overall concern and questions were how we are going to handle the number of people who are going to need help, and what will we be able to do for them?

The answer was the same as it has always been at Grace Place....

"We will feed the people, because that is what Jesus instructed us to do. God knows the needs of His people. We trust Him and have faith that we will be able to meet their needs. Jesus multiplied the two fish and the five loaves of bread....and we see that lived out every day! Sometimes it is down to the last serving, but we NEVER run out of hot meals! Praise God! We are not fearful; we have faith that God will provide for our ministry to feed and clothe the poor and the most vulnerable."

It is through your support and your prayers and through the power and the grace of God that we can do this!!!



Throughout the Bible, many taught us to care for the hungry:

Jesus explicitly and repeatedly calls his followers to "feed the hungry" and care for the poor, making it a fundamental aspect of faith and a condition for eternal life.

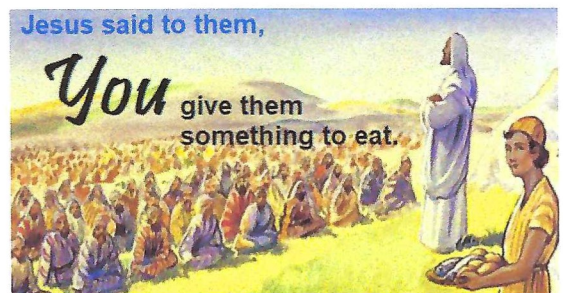
John the Baptist, in the Gospel of Luke, instructed those with extra tunics or food to share with those who have none.

In Leviticus 23, God instructed the Israelite landowners that they were not allowed to harvest the grain from the corners of their fields, because those areas had to be set aside for the poor and most vulnerable in their communities.

We are feeding an average of 4,400 hot meals per month now and serving an average of 1,700 through our food pantry distribution. We are so grateful to God for this opportunity and responsibility. And we appreciate all the support, the volunteers, and the prayers that allow us to serve the hungriest and the most vulnerable in our community.

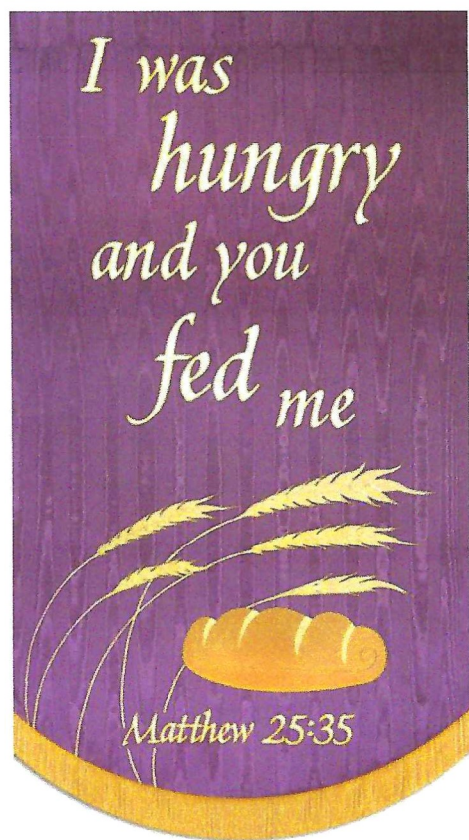
Hot Meals & Food Pantry
