“Miracles in the Storm”

Rhonda's previous newsletter "Focus" was about focusing on Jesus rather than the storm, and those words certainly foreshadowed one of the worst storms we have all ever experienced!!! But amidst the storm, watching our community support each other and pour blessings on each other was incredibly beautiful!

Grace Place didn't lose electricity, water, or sustain any damage, but our parking lot was covered in a thick sheet of ice for about 7 days. Our roof had sheets of ice crashing to the ground for many days after the storm. It wasn't safe for the public to be near the building. We were concerned about not being able to provide meals and food to people who we know depend on us! However, the Lord made a divine connection with World Central Kitchen, and we were able to still feed people outside on the outer perimeter of the property for 6 days using a Food Truck. We averaged 600 meals per day, and it was such a blessing to see all of our community again! We got to connect with many new people and work crews as well.

We visited and shared resources with the area's warming station, where most of our homeless population were staying. It was such a relief that they were given shelter and such joy to see them and reconnect and pray with them.

We know the Lord will work miracles even in the midst of a storm. One tremendous miracle we witnessed was with one of our mothers and her children. This precious mother has 4 children (the youngest being just 3 weeks old). She had recently fled her home from a domestic situation and was now homeless. The days leading up to the storm she stayed at a Motel 6, but was out of funds to afford any more nights. A volunteer who just happened to be here with us the day before the storm (praise God!) overheard our concern for this family & offered her Airbnb for the family for a week!!

It was the most beautiful home in the garden district. The family and us were just overwhelmed with the volunteer's kindness and compassion for this family. They were sheltered from the storm in the most beautiful home, and the surrounding neighbors were so kind and compassionate to them. But the Lord's miracles and divine connections didn't stop there!

After the storm, we needed to help find the family a new place. In 24 hours, with the guidance of the Lord and His divine connections again, an affordable rent house was found, 4 beds were donated, a washer & dryer, refrigerator, microwave, rugs, living room furniture, boxes of housewares, a brand new stove and more!!! It was truly a miracle to see how the Lord works! And FAST!! 😊

We hope to continue to be a part of this family's journey and witness the Lord direct their paths.

The support and prayers we receive from our community allow us to go outside the Soup Kitchen to bless families like this!! We are so humbled and appreciate your kindness, support, prayers, generosity, and compassion for our community!

And we are most grateful to our loving Father for all His blessings and the Miracles He performs even in the midst of storms!! *psalms.*
